ASSAM ACT No. III OF 1985

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No. I) ACT, 1985

An

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year, 1984-85.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly in the Thirty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. I) Act, 1985.

Withdrawal of Rs.343,41,68,500 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1984-85. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of three hundred forty-three crores, forty-one lakhs, sixty-eight thousand and five hundred rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year, 1984-85 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedules

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
